Last month after some rehabilitation, Julie was released from the Hospital in Fort Collins Colorado.

We stayed at the KOA until after Independence Day, and then departed for home in the RV.

It was an interesting trip and we arrived home on the fifth day. Our route included stays in WaKeeney Kansas, Columbia Missouri, Shepherdsville Kentucky, and finally Kinards South Carolina (Newberry).

Our second night stay was in Columbia MO at "Cottonwoods RV Park & Campground". It was a nice Campground with lots of amenities and located off the beaten path.



Our last night stay was at the KOA in Newberry SC. It's the same KOA we stayed at during the SC Rally, and we have reservations to return next year during the 2025 District Rally.

Two days after our return home, Julie was at her follow-up appointment at Mayo Hospital. After a few more X-Rays, the decision was made to remove the full leg cast (Puppy Paws) and replace it with a brace for the next 6-10 weeks.

If things go well with the leg, beginning August 1st we can adjust the brace for 30 degrees movement. A few weeks later, if updated X-Rays show improvement, she will be allowed to adjust to 60 degrees.

It's a slow process, but the kneecap needs to heal completely before she tries to walk on it. The difficult part is keeping her off the leg during the healing process. Thank goodness for Walkers and Wheelchairs!

Unfortunately, our travel plans will have to change this year. We will have to cancel our visit to the EWMA International Rally in Green Bay, Wisconsin at the end of this month.

If things work out, we hope to make the North Carolina Rally, "Wings Over the Smokies", scheduled for the 20th and 21st of September.

The Mississippi Rally, scheduled for October 24th through 26th, is still on our schedule and we hope Julie can throw her leg over the Trike by then. Only time will tell.

We would like to thank the Chapter for the Get-Well cards, phone calls, and visit from our Directors, Ed and Jeanette.

Family: 3 years \$80, 2 years \$55, 1 year \$30

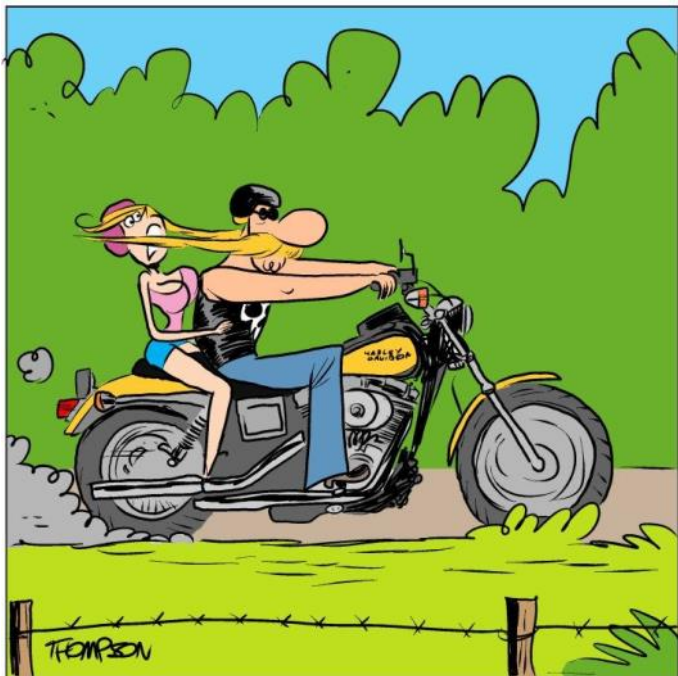
Julie and I renewed our family membership for 2 years. If you have any questions, just reach out to us or our Chapter Directors.

RIDING IN THE HEAT

It's hot!!! I guess I don't have to tell you that. Here are a few tips and facts that might help you make the best of it. Ride early in the morning or in the evening when it is cooler. Use sunscreen in direct sunlight. Wear long sleeves. I know that is contrary to what most riders want to do. Having covered skin in hot weather is actually better physically for you. If your skin is exposed the hot air rushes past your body and will dry you out. Just in the same manner you dry your hands in the hand blower in the restroom. Wear a helmet visor to keep the hot air from hitting you in the face. You can wet your shirt under your mesh motorcycle jacket. You could put a cool tie around your neck. You could wear an ice vest. You could carry a mist spray bottle. Have drink holders on your bike for you and your passenger.

There are three physical concerns you should think about: Dehydration, Heat Exhaustion, and Heat Stroke.

- * Dehydration Symptoms: Dry or sticky mouth
 - * Low or no urine output or concentrated urine appears dark yellow
 - * Not producing tears
 - * Sunken eyes
 - * Lethargic
- * Dehydration Treatment: Seek shade or air conditioning
 - * Drink additional water or sport drinks (diluted 50/50 with water)
 - * If possible decrease the time between rest stops
- * Heat Exhaustion Symptoms: Loss of large amounts of fluid through sweating
 - * Sweating, clammy and moist skin with pale or flushed complexion
 - * Extreme weakness or fatigue, giddiness, nausea, headache, or irritability
 - * Vomiting
 - * Loss of consciousness
- * Heat Exhaustion Treatment: Drink additional water or sport drinks (diluted 50/50 with water)
 - * Apply cool compresses or ice packs to the neck, groin, and arm pits
- * Heat Stroke Symptoms: Hot, dry, flushed or spotted skin
 - * Severe headache
 - * Exhaustion
 - * Bizarre behavior
 - * Hallucinations
 - * Altered mental status

- * Confusion
- * Disorientation
- * Possible convulsions and coma
- * Heat Stroke Treatment: Call EMS (911) this is a medical emergency
 - * Move rider to a cool place
 - * Reduce rider's body heat immediately by any means available
